


Types of Patients



- Patients with international Health Insurances (AXA, Buba Int. etc.)
- E110 / E111 Form Patients
- Patients sent through Embassies (Saudi-Arabia, Kuwait, UAE etc.)
- Self-Paying Patients (directly or specialized agencies)

International Department



For quick and efficient processing of treatment inquiries, and suggesting adequate treatment options, International Department asks patients to send medical records including the following:

- Typed doctor's reports, not older than 3 months in German or English
- Imaging scans (for instance magnetic resonance imaging, computerized tomography, X-ray scans) not older than 3 months (digital as DICOM - Digital Imaging and Communications in Medicine)
- Laboratory test results
- Release from medical confidentiality for third-party inquiries

Treatment Cost



Immediately upon receipt of an inquiry for medical treatment, the team of International Department is sending it to the chief physician of the relevant specialty department.

Upon reply – which normally takes one to two workdays – relevant information on treatment option is sent by e-mail including a rough cost estimate. Treatment option is serving as basis for our “cost estimate”. This will be a rough cost estimate only, because costs may be lower or higher depending on the course of treatment.

Prior to starting treatment, it is required that the full amount of cost estimate is paid as advance deposit to the account of Klinikum Nuremberg specified.

Cost Categories



Klinikum Nürnberg offers three different cost categories to the Patient:

- Economy
- Business
- First Class

During treatment a personal interpreter takes care of patient, German speaking interpreter is mandatory!

Visa Application

International Department is providing official confirmation of appointments scheduled if you wish to file a visa application with the German Embassy in your home country for obtaining a visa for entry to Germany for medical treatment.

Copies of patient's passport and if necessary of an accompanying person needed to complete this process. We have to confirm information to the German Embassy in your home country that full advance payment was received for coverage of treatment costs. Therefore, a letter of certification can only be made upon receipt of full advance deposit.
